

A **Special Meeting of Port District No. 1 of Grant County** was held at the Port District office at 101 F Street SW on **October 25, 2018** to discuss the biogas opportunities.

Commissioner Curt Morris called the meeting to order at 10:10 am. Also, present were Commissioner Brian Kuest, Commissioner Pat Connelly, William Evans, Damon Taam, and Cassi Calloway.

Commissioner Morris opens public meeting. William Evans presented a biogas pilot project using a fruit digester. Mr. Evans said the fruit digester would turn the fruit into 98% clean gas and that all wastewater and solids would be organic. Mr. Evans stated they are just at the beginning of planning stages hoping to start pilot project early Spring of 2019. Commissioner Morris said to contact the Port or the City of Quincy for property options when they are further into the planning process.


Upon motion by Commissioner Connelly, seconded by Commissioner Kuest, signing the Resolution 2018-06 was approved.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:00 am.


